

Important points to keep in mind when transferring the ownership

Update following documentation :

1. Certificate of registry :

2. MMSI registration:

To modify an existing MMSI or to assign a new MMSI, you must complete online the *Form AB — Ship station with VHF/DSC only, unlicensed or licensed radio*:

Once you have completed the form, click Submit at the bottom of the page. The form will be directed to the appropriate district office based on the applicant's address.

3. EPIRB Registration:

The seller of the vessel must call and notify the registry of the sale.

Then, the new owner must contact the registry to update the information relating to the emergency beacon. If these steps are not taken, the search will be based on outdated and inaccurate information.

If you have a registered emergency beacon, it is important that the information be accurate. Please update the information in the registry:

- if you move
- if you want to update the emergency contact information
- if your phone number changes, or
- if any of the important information in the registry changes such as colour of vessel.
